



Leaders' Core Proposed Sprayground

The City of Longview is building a park in the Northwest Corner between Fenton Road and George Richey. Presently, the Neil McCoy playground, three baseball fields, and one t-ball field are up and running. The city also hopes to create a walking trail. We plan to develop and build as partners with the Parks Department, a water playground, a.k.a. a sprayground. The city has created a small sprayground in South Longview, and we only have two other water-recreational facilities: Ingram pool in the Eastern-Central area of the city and Pine Tree pool. The need is there, and for our sprayground, we have designed a shipwreck theme. We are also excited because the City of Longview Parks department has pledged to help us in any way they can.

Sprayground Cost and Sponsorships

This plan will cost approximately \$150,000. The city will help with some expenses, and we hope to take advantage of in-kind donations, but most of the money will have to be raised. We plan to present to local businesses and individuals who are interested in improving their city, and we have developed a sponsorship program. Presently we have approximately \$25,000 raised. Hopefully, by next summer, we will be holding a grand open and ribbon cutting for the new City of Longview water playground.
